#### **Course Description including Aims**

This module is the technical part of year 3 of the Masters with a Modern Language programme. Students choose their third year topics, in consultation with the Departmental Erasmus co-ordinator, to cover the same or similar material to that which they would have studied in Sheffield. There is always some technical mismatch between the Sheffield third year and the European institution concerned. There is also mismatch in the way European institutions and Sheffield allocate credits to units of study but the aim is to arrange a study programme that is equivalent to 100 Sheffield credits (or 1000 hours of study) and since there are only four institutions that we have an agreement with, we have sufficient experience now to get close to that objective. We encourage students to opt for a group project where possible to help their team working and language skills.
